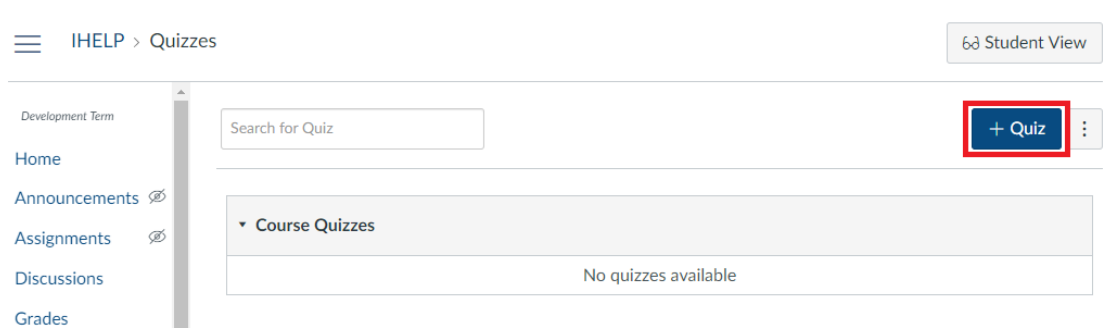


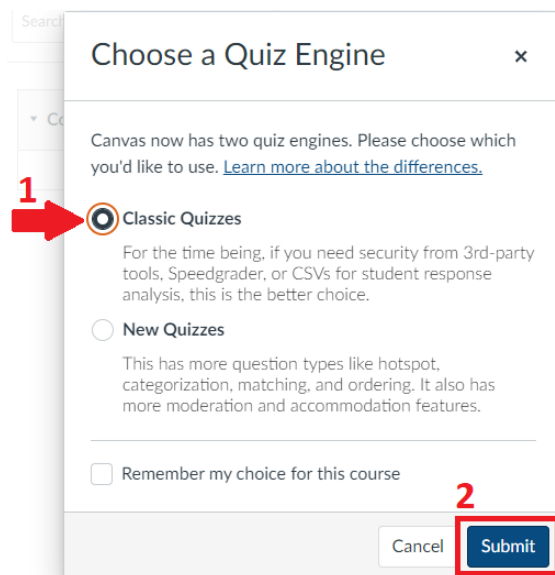
Migrating Content from Question Banks into Item Banks

Canvas does not have a tool for the automatic migration of content from Question Banks (Classic Quizzes) to Item Banks (New Quizzes). This guide is intended to assist you in manually transferring the information from Question Banks to Item Banks. In this process, you will need to create a Classic Quiz with all your desired questions and then manually transfer them to an Item Bank for New Quizzes.

1. Go to the Quizzes tab in your course and select “+Quiz”



2. Create the quiz
 1. Select “Classic Quizzes”
 2. Click “Submit”



3. In this step make sure to:
 1. Enter a name for the quiz
 2. Click on the “Questions” tab at the top

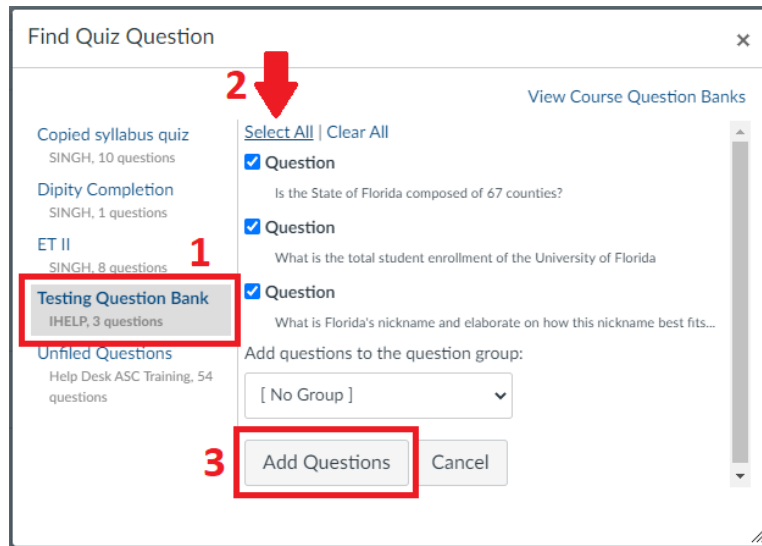

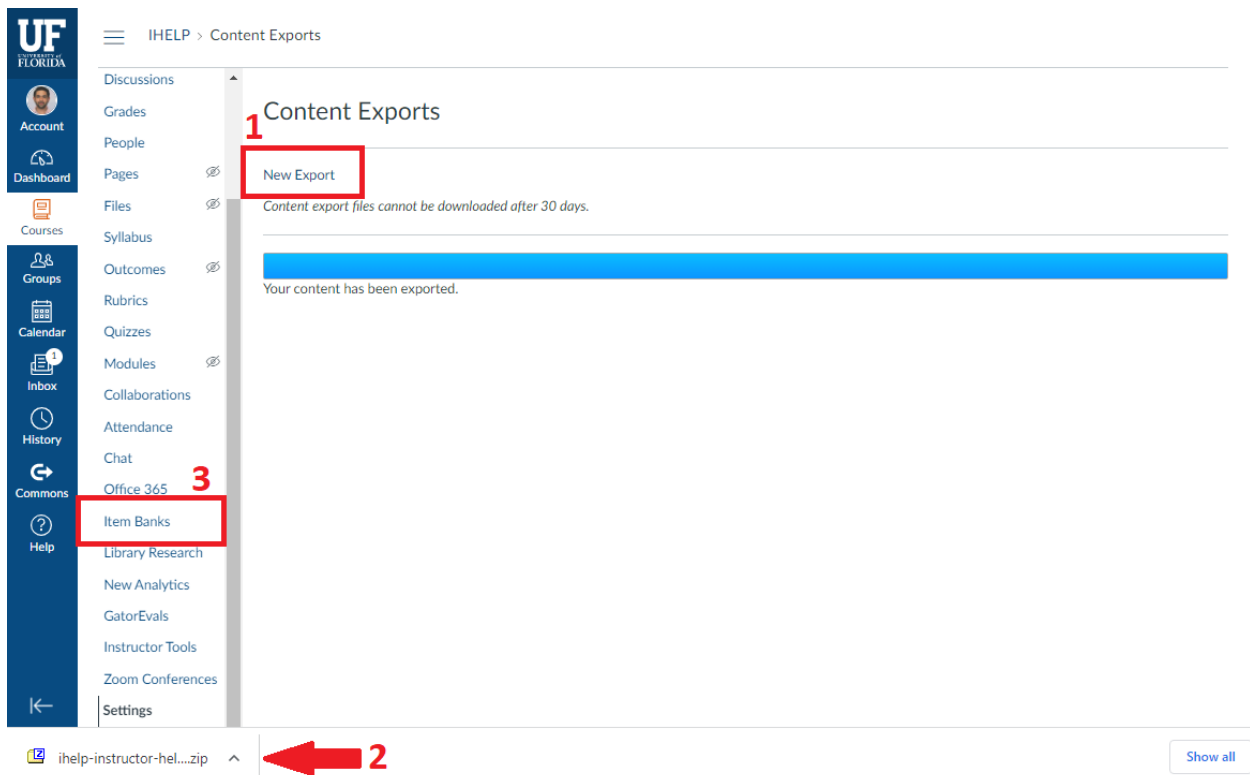

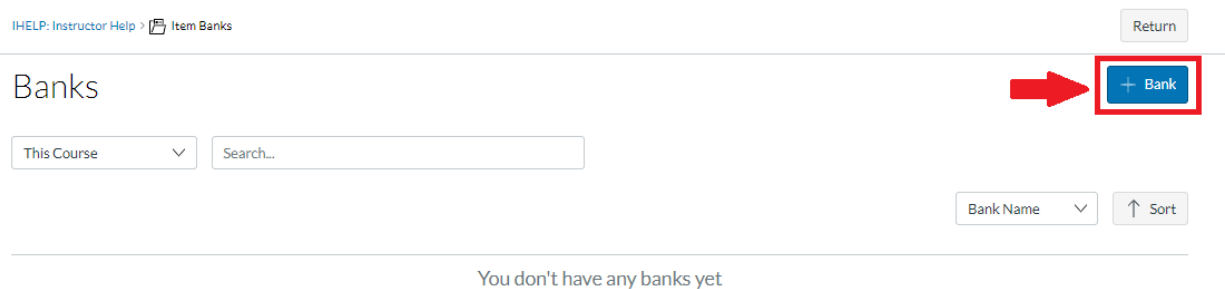

9. When the system finishes exporting the quiz, make sure to

1. Click the “New Export” link to start downloading the quiz
2. You will see that the file is downloading at the bottom of the screen if using Chrome, or at the top right corner if using Firefox. Independent of the browser, the file will go to your “Downloads” folder in your computer
3. Go to the “Item Banks” option in your course’s menu



10. Click “+ Bank” to create a new item bank



11. In the new window, make sure to

1. Name the new item bank
2. Click "Create Bank"

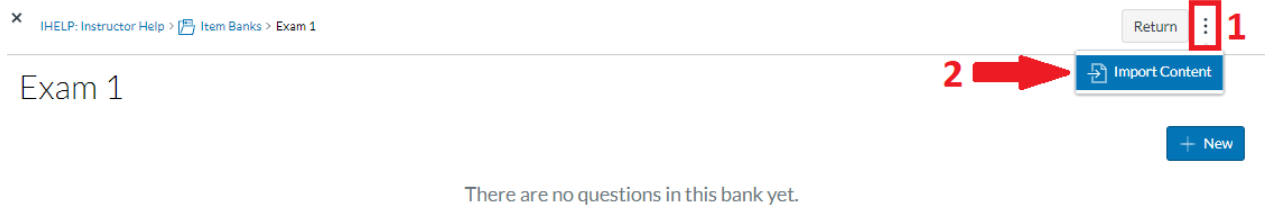

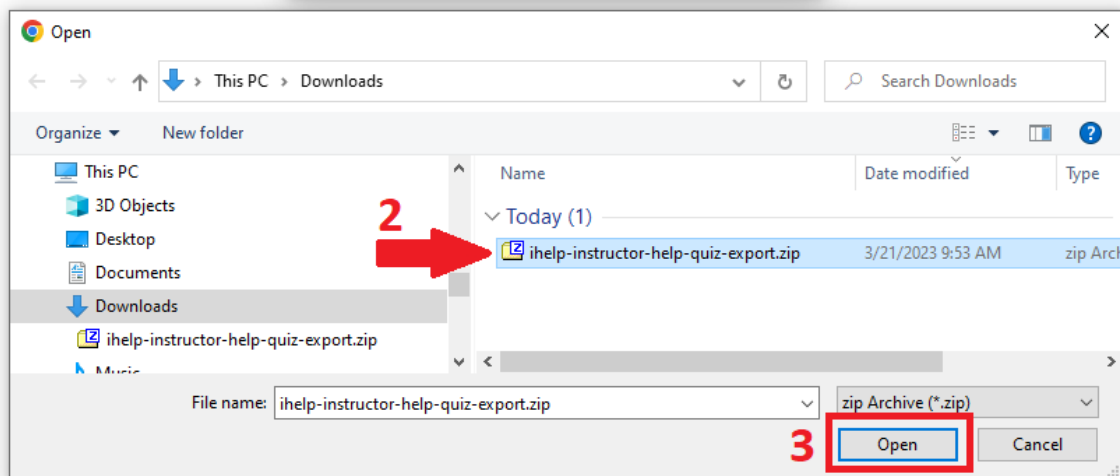
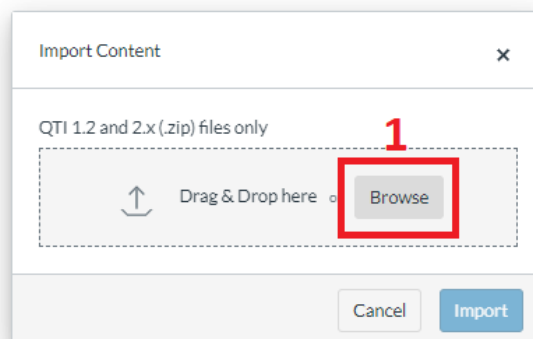
13. After clicking on the new item bank, you will see that it is empty

1. Click the kebab menu (three vertical dots)
2. Click "Import Content"

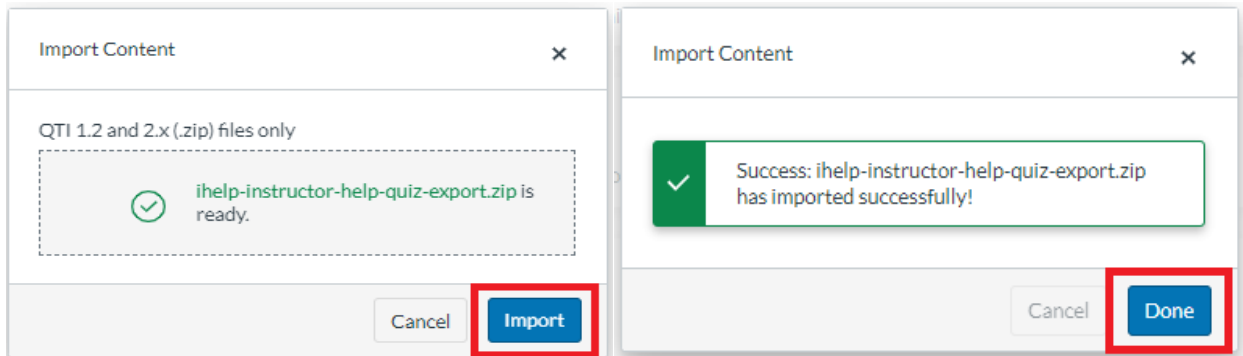


14. A window for "Import Content" will open up

1. Click "Browse" to open the file explorer on your computer
2. Go to your "Downloads" folder and click on the quiz you exported in step 9
3. Click "Open"



15. Once the import has finished, you will see the title of the file in green next to a check mark. Make sure to click “Import” and then click “Done”



16. The process is done when you see your questions listed under the title of the item bank
